The Drug Medi-Cal Substance Use Disorder (SUD) Plan has a variety of substance use treatment services.

If you have Santa Cruz County Medi-Cal, then you may be referred to as a “beneficiary” who would be eligible to receive SUD service from Drug Medi-Cal delivery system.

### Who Can Access Substance Use Disorder Treatment?

- Medi-Cal Beneficiaries
- Youth (Ages 12-17)
- Adults
- ASAM Criteria Met
- First Step = Contact an Intake Coordinator to do a brief screening
